EWU Receives Permanent Government Certificate on its 15th Convocation



East West University has received permanent certificate upon fulfilling all the requirements recommended by the government. The Education Minister Nurul Islam Nahid, M. P. said that the government will take lawful action against those private universities, who were unable to fulfill their criterion within the given ultimatum of one year. The 15th Convocation of East West University was held on Wednesday morning at the permanent campus at Aftabnagar, Dhaka. A total of 1311 undergraduate and graduate students were conferred degrees, and three of them won gold medals.

Professor Abdul Mannan, Chairman, University Grants Commission (UGC) and Special Guest at the Convocation, stated that the private universities ought to provide scholarships to facilitate the financially insolvent meritorious students.

Renown educationalist and the Convocation Speaker, Dr. Muhammed Zafar Iqbal spoke to the graduating students that there is no success without failure as success comes after a lot of failed attempts. He, thus, urged them not to lose hope but to be optimistic in practical life. Dr. Zafar Iqbal also advised the graduating students to learn to enjoy the pleasure of doing something for others in our brief span of life.

The Chairperson of the Board of Trustees of East West University and former Governor of Bangladesh Bank, Dr.

Mohammed Farashuddin stated that the intolerance prevailing in our society in recent times is quite depressing. He expressed his hope that students of East West University will be inspired by honesty, skill and patriotism, and will play a key role in building a liberal and democratic society.

Obituary

Mr. Jalaluddin Ahmed, former Secretary of Bangladesh Government and Member of the Board of Trustees of East West

University breathed his last at Mount Elizabeth Hospital in Singapore on 3 March 2016 Thursday He was 79 years old. He left behind his spouse Nazma Ahmed, son Nehal, daughter Chandrima and a host of relatives and admirers. He was buried in Uttara graveyard. East West University expressed deep condolence at his death and prayed to the Almighty for the salvation of the departed soul.

Mr. Jalaluddin Ahmed joined the erst-while Civil Service of Pakistan (CSP) in 1961 and retired as a Secretary of Bangladesh Government in 1994. He served as the

Chairman of Petrobangla and many other important assignments of Bangladesh government. He was also the regional advisor of International Labour Organization (ILO) and United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA). His namaz e janaza was held at 11:30 AM on 5 March 2016 at East West University premises, Aftab Nagar, Dhaka. Chairperson

of Board of Trustees Dr. Mohammed Farashuddin, Members, Board of Trustees, Vice Chancellor Prof. M.M. Shahidul Hassan, Treasurer, Deans of the faculties, faculty members and staff of East West University were present at the namaz e ianaza.

The workshop focused on in-depth analysis of genderclimate interrelation that can better inform climate policy in Bangladesh as well as international focus to bring together researchers, policy makers and practitioners to share their experiences of linking gender and climate change in policies. Building on unique experiences, the workshop aimed to deconstruct popular assumptions about women's vulnerability in relation to men's by discussing how socioeconomic factors determine men and women's vulnerability to climate change.

Ms. Christine Hunter, UN Women Bangladesh, Country

Representative was the Chief Guest of the workshop. Dr. Mohammed Farashuddin, Chairperson, Board of Trustees and Founder Vice Chancellor. East West University was the Special Guest and Professor M. M. Shahidul Hassan, Vice Chancellor, East West University was the Guest of Honor. Dr. Rafiqul Huda Chaudhury. Chairperson. East West University Center for Research and Training presided over the program. The Keynote Speakers were Ms. Farah Kabir, Director, Action Aid, Bangladesh and Ms. Dilruba Haider, Coordinator, Gender and Climate Change. UN Women. The workshop was participated by a galaxy of experts in the field, high government officials, and representatives of national and international development agencies. The meeting concluded with a set of recommendations, which are as follows:

- gender is still not well defined at the policy level in Bangladesh, especially in the context of climate change
- investment in education and health of children and adolescents is the foremost important entry to prepare our next generation free from gender biased mindset, to meet the current and emerging sustainable development challenges of the country including climate change issues and to promote sustained economic advancement
- access to productive resources for women should be enhanced, particularly in female headed households
- curriculum should be revised from gender perspective and teachers need to be trained to become agents of social change
- vulnerability assessment of climate change related disasters should be assessed through gender lens
- gender concerns should be well integrated into 7th Five-year Development Plan (2015/16-2019-20), and for which a gender group should be created; furthermore a gender group should also be created to implement COP24 resolutions in the context of Bangladesh

The workshop identified institutional culture, patriarchal mindset and lack of adequate budget in relation to gender and climate change as key challenges in Bangladesh.




Prize Winners of the Intra Department Sports Tournament 2016 with Dean, Faculty of Sciences and engineering, EWU.

GEB Department arranged a study tour at National Institute of Biotechnology (NIB) and Atomic Energy Research Establishment (AERE), Savar on 2 February 2016. The students were exposed to the real world of basic and applied science at these both Bangladeshi leading research institutes.

NIB is conducting research to develop eco-friendly and sustainable technology in agriculture, environment, industry and human health using modern biotechnology. At NIB, the students visited the laboratory of Molecular Biotechnology and Microbial Biotechnology, and learned about different molecular biology techniques along with GCMS and HPLC systems.

At AERE, students and faculty members visited the Institute of Food and Radiation Biology (IFRB) where the GEB Chairperson Dr. Md. Mohiuddin Kabir was appointed as a Scientific Officer in 1999. The IFRB was established in 1979 for the peaceful application of nuclear energy in the field of biological sciences.

The core facility of IFRB is a Cobalt-60 gamma irradiator, which is operated and maintained by Gamma Source Division. The most research activities of the institute are based on gamma irradiation. In addition to research, this source renders limited scale commercial service to private stakeholders particularly to pharmaceutical industries.
