1. What do you think about the current functioning of East West University?

East West University was established in 1996 by a group of dedicated educationists, public servants, social workers, and corporate personnel and UN Professionals. From a small beginning, University has grown in size and strength.

Initially University was accommodated in a few hired buildings at Mohakahli and now it has shifted to its newly built well-designed, well-planned and impressive campus at Aftabnagar, Dhaka which can accommodate more than eight thousand students in conformity with its motto to ensure high quality education, equality, fair play and justice, it has exceeded our expectations. Since its inception, the University has laid emphasis on recruitment of well-qualified faculty members and admitting students on highly competitive basis through written and oral test. The University provides Merit Scholarships, Medha Lalon Fund Scholarships, Freedom Fighter Scholarships, Divisional Quota and generous financial assistance to the needy students.

Under the able guidance and policy directions of the Board of Trustees dedicated and highly qualified faculty and competent Staff members, East West University has come to be recognized as one of the top ranking private Universities in the country in respect of quality of education and research. No University can excel in educational achievements without back up support from research. Therefore, East West University has promoted research from the beginning and set up a Centre for Research and Training (CRT)

2. How would you like to see the University in the next 10 years?

The Board of Trustees have already decided to open the Department of Law. We have approximately 19 bighas of land at Vadam, Ashulia where we have further plans of constructing a residential Nursing College, Medical College and Hospital.

3. How do you advise our students to make the best use of their time?

I would like to tell our students to know that East West University has contributed significantly in raising the standards of the quality of private sector tertiary education in the Country within a short time. This has been a prolonged endeavour in terms of the vision of its founding fathers, its curriculum diversity, its uptodate
